Wind load requirements _____

This is to advise that we have reviewed the drawings and specifications (construction documents) for the proposed building construction and have determined that they appear to comply with the adopted laws, codes, rules and regulations of Vermilion Parish, Louisiana regarding flood zone elevation only. Issuance of a building permit is subject to compliance with Act No. 12 (1st Extraordinary Session 2005) and Act No. 11 (1st Extraordinary Session 2006) provisions for Emergency Wind and Flood Prevention Measures in accordance with applicable sections of the International Residential Code (IRC)-2003 Edition, and/or the International Building Code (IBC)-2003 Edition, as adopted for the Louisiana ‘State Uniform Construction Code’. All permit applications shall be accompanied by drawings and/or specifications certified in writing by an approved third party (i.e: design professional, ICC Certified Code Official or other approved party under Act No. 12; and Licensed Contractors, classification “Building Construction”, or “Residential Building Contractors” for Single Family Residences only, under Act No. 11, referenced above) to comply with the specified wind and flood provisions and shall further certify that the building’s foundation and structural design are in accordance with prevailing soil conditions at the building site.

Neither the issuance of a permit nor the performance of any enforcement procedure nor any provision of a building code shall constitute or be construed as a warranty or guarantee by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury as to durability or fitness, or as a warranty or guarantee by a governmental enforcement official that said building, structure, or other improvement to immovable property or any materials, equipment, or method or type of construction used therein is or will be free from defects, will perform in a particular manner, is fit for a particular purpose, or will last in any particular way.

Occupancy of any structure shall not be granted without said third party inspection certification of the building during construction, as provided for in Act No. 12 and Act No. 11. All approvals and subsequent construction must be in compliance with the Louisiana ‘State Uniform Construction Code’ as adopted by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury.

The undersigned acknowledges that they have received and understood the above requirements and agree to comply with the laws, codes, rules and regulations adopted by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury and further assume full responsibility for meeting all of the above requirements during the construction of the referenced building.
